Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

We are saddened by yet another tragedy which happened soon after the earthquake in Haiti. Last weekend, an earthquake measuring 8.8 on the Moment Magnitude Scale has killed over 700 people in Chile and the figure is expected to rise. It also caused massive destruction to buildings and other facilities. More than 2 million people are said to be affected by the earthquake.

As we pray for the people in Chile, Caritas Internationalis is helping. In Singapore, the Archdiocesan Crisis Coordination Team (ACCT) is working with Caritas Internationalis to provide any financial support needed. If you wish to donate to the earthquake victims, you may give it to the priests.
